*What is the PFATS Format?

This single-elimination format, **Player Friendly Advanced Tournament System (PFATS)**, was developed by **Charles Mackintosh**. All qualifiers are single elimination, qualifiers play in consecutive matches until complete, each qualifier qualifies the top two teams for the finals bracket, each event's finals bracket has four teams, once you qualify for the finals bracket you are "in the money", you may only play in one qualifier at a time, and you may enter as many qualifiers as you are eligible for.
